

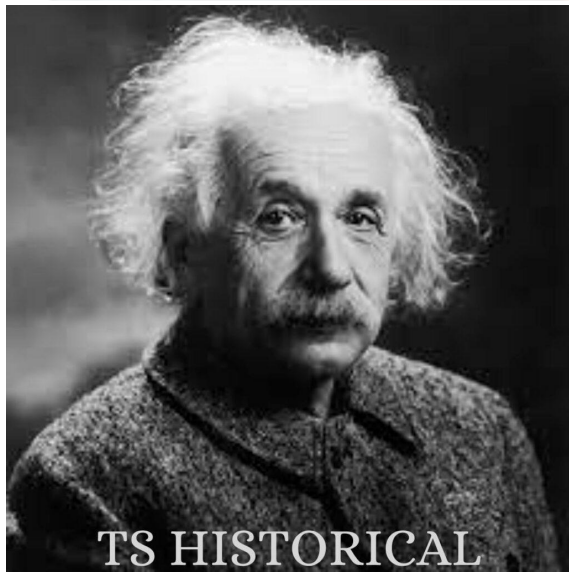

Albert Einstein's educational background

Albert Einstein: In March 14, 1879, in Um Wittenberg [Germany](#) baby Einstein was born with a swollen mishap and head and a grossly overweight body birth Einstein frightened his mother as he had an abnormally big head of course as time went on it shrank to normal size as a child Einstein started speaking late and even then his speech was often awkward perhaps his poor communication skills were due not to a



lack of intelligence but to a lack of interest in interacting with others when Albert Einstein was five years old.

his father showed him a simple pocket compass and what force exerted itself on the little needle to make it point in a single direction this question stayed with Einstein for years and it the beginning of his lifelong interest in physics when he was 13 years old he started playing violin his violin was named Lena einstein continued to play the violin until.

The last few years of his life Einstein had trouble in school is a myth the fact is that Einstein hated rote learning and refused to study subjects that didn't interest his records show that he was an exceptional student he got high grades during his school days in Munich he was even considered something of a prodigy for his grasp of complex mathematical and scientific concepts Einstein

Albert Einstein co-invented a refrigerator with his former student Leo Cellar that operated on compressed gases this **Nobel prize** winner also had a deep interest in topics like humanity war and peace and religion einstein's scientific ideas made his name a synonym for genius but he was also famous for his pacifist views and support of the civil rights movements einstein had a poor memory he often forgot names face dates and phone numbers einstein's it was never tested lots of websites claimed that his IQ was 160.

But there's simply no way of verifying that claim of course einstein was the greatest theoretical physicist of the 20th century so he must have had a superlative iq einstein's brain was overall smaller than average but the parietal lobes were 15 percent wider than normal these areas are linked to the mathematical ability and visual and spatial awareness on her 72nd birthday.

Einstein was living in even held by his owner as he was getting into his car photographers asked him to smile for the camera he was tired of posing for a photograph so he popped his tongue out instead of the famous American photographer Arthur Sass took this photograph and what he got became a classic in 1952 number nine first president of Israel came wise man died after that Einstein was asked if he would accept the position of being the second president of Israel 73-year-old.

Einstein declined the offer in his official letter of refusal Einstein stated that he lacked the natural aptitude and the experience to deal with people Einstein loved sailing even though he never learned to swim he kept sailing as a hobby throughout his life Einstein received countless letters from the public but he always tried to answer mail sent by children Einstein never had the car of his own and he never learned to drive Einstein was curious about inventing and would secure approximately 50 patents during his lifetime. Albert Einstein died at Princeton Hospital on April 18, 1955.

He refused surgical treatment he explained I want to go when I want it is tasteless to prolong life artificially I have done my share it is time to go I will do it elegantly right before he died Einstein uttered his final words to a nurse in German, unfortunately, the nurse didn't speak or understand German Thomas Harvey the pathologist who looked after Einstein's autopsy took his brain without permission Dr Harvey eventually received permission from the family members to keep the brain but only on the condition that it be used for scientific research the Mütter Museum in Philadelphia is one of only two places in the world.

Where you can see pieces of Albert Einstein's brain this Nobel prize winner's journey and the world did not end at his death in some ways it had just begun even today Einstein is considered to be one of the most popular scientists ever to live we have to respect the sheer intelligence and brilliance that was Albert Einstein.
