



1. George Washington, Founding Father & 1st President of the United States of America




George Washington, Founding Father & 1st President of the United States

2. Benjamin Franklin Founding Father of the United States




Benjamin Franklin Founding Father of the United States

3. John Adams, Founding Father & 2nd President of the United States




John Adams, Founding Father & 2nd President of the United States

4. Thomas Jefferson, Founding Father & 3rd President of the United States




Alexander Hamilton, Founding Father of the United States of America
